ENCOURAGING WORD FOR THE WEEK.

HAVE A PRUDENT MIND

Beloved prudent is defined as “acting with or showing care and thought for the future” some of the synonyms are wise, judicious, shrewd, advisable, sensible, cautious, careful, and wary. It is written in Proverbs 18:15 “The mind of the prudent acquires knowledge, and the ear of the wise seeks knowledge”. This shows that we should all strive to have a prudent mind. In Luke 2:41-52 we were told how our Lord Jesus at the age of 12 was in the Temple asking and answering questions.

One section of the book of Proverbs concentrates on the value of wisdom and the dangers of recklessness while others give advice on things like practical morality, pleasing the Lord, the value of righteousness, the dangers of temptation and the fruit of godly living.

Please look at the following verses:

- Proverbs 24:5 “The wise prevail through great power, and those who have knowledge muster their strength”.
- Proverbs 1:7 “The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction”.
- Proverbs 2:6 “For the LORD gives wisdom; from his mouth come knowledge and understanding”.

Prov. Chapter 18, touches on the benefits and rewards of friendships, whilst warning of the drawback of living in isolation and self-centredness. A close-minded person lacks sound judgement and often spews out unwise words based on their own limited understanding and from their own biased perspective, "but the mind of the prudent acquires knowledge, and the ear of the wise seeks understanding".

As the psalm progresses we continue to see a contrast between the way of the wise who desire wisdom and have a teachable spirit and the fool, who not only says in their heart there is no God, but also identifies their reckless stupidity with foul language, ill-thought out opinions and contentious arguments.

The mind of a discerning person is ready to gain knowledge and understanding. They present their line of reasoning in a wise, circumspect, far-sighted and judicious manner. This is a person who engages in lifelong learning in areas that honour the Lord, that contribute to their own eternal benefit, as well as the edification of others.

The ear of the wise is ever open to the truth. They desire understanding and try to put their knowledge into practice. They are willing to receive instruction rather than to being unduly self-assured or exhibiting a 'know-it-all' attitude. They demonstrate a gracious humility rather than egocentric pride, they are interested in what they can learn rather than trumpeting what they already know.

As with so much of life, acquiring knowledge, understanding and seeking after wisdom is a choice for the individual. Each one of us have the freewill to choose the good and eschew the evil, to be prudent and diligently acquire knowledge or take the alternate course of pursuing folly and become ensnared in our foolishness. We can turn our ear to seeking knowledge and develop humility of heart and we can pursue the path of prudence and seek after that which is more valuable than gold that will last throughout life and into eternity.

Although the unregenerate person can gain much value from reading the book of Proverbs and applying its wisdom in their lives, the underlying principle that should govern our acquisition of knowledge and understanding, is to reverence the Lord in the beauty of His holiness, for doing so will not only influence this life we are living today, in a positive way, but will enable us to reap glorious rewards in the eternal ages to come.
